Two of the JGHS buildings were named by pupils after prominent local individuals, one with a close connection to the school, former pupil and author Muriel Spark, and athlete Eric Liddell who represented Edinburgh, Scotland and GB at the 1924

Olympics. The Muriel Spark Building and the Eric Liddell Building,

Both individuals also now have paths on Bruntsfield Links named after them.


